



Doggy Rules

Welcome to our campsite, where we gladly welcome
our four-legged friends.

To ensure safety, tranquility, and a friendly atmosphere for
everyone, please take note of the following rules:



Identification and Vaccination

All dogs must be microchipped and up to date with their vaccinations. This measure ensures the health and well-being of our furry friends.



Category 1 and 2 Dogs

During the summer season (July-August), Category 1 and 2 dogs are not allowed.

In the low season, presenting a possession permit and wearing a muzzle are mandatory.



Access to Bungalows:

Dogs are welcome in all our bungalows (limited to 2 per bungalow). In bungalows equipped with a jacuzzi, dogs are not allowed in the jacuzzi.



Leash Requirement Within the Campsite:

Dogs must be kept on a leash within the campsite, except in the designated doggy park for play and relaxation.



Doggy Park:

As the dog park is not fenced, it is the owner's responsibility to ensure their dog is trained to obey off-leash commands.

A good recall is essential in the dog park. Dogs are also encouraged to enjoy the agility equipment provided for their entertainment.



Owner's Responsibility

Dogs remain under their owner's responsibility at all times.

Letting a dog off-leash is at the owner's own risk, and they will be held accountable in case of any incident involving other animals, people, or property.

Dogs must not be left alone at the campsite, even if confined, in the absence of their owners, who are legally responsible.



Interaction with Other Animals

It is strictly forbidden to pet or feed an animal without the prior permission of its owner. Children must be supervised by their legal guardian when interacting with animals.



Children as Dog Owners

Children who are responsible for a dog must be accompanied by their legal guardian when taking care of it.



No Singing Contest Training

Dogs are on vacation, just like the humans in the neighboring bungalow. Therefore, any singing contest training is prohibited.



Management of Dog Waste

The owner is required to pick up their dog's waste and dispose of it responsibly. Waste bags are available at the reception.



Responsibility for Damages

The owner is responsible for any damages caused by their pet in the rentals and to outdoor equipment.

They must report such damages and have insurance covering any harm caused by their animal.



Non-compliance with the Rules

In the event of non-compliance with these rules, the campsite reserves the right to cancel the reservation without compensation.
